1. Application eligibility

Those who can enroll as research students in the Master's Level Section of the Integrated Course are those who fall under any of the items in Paragraph 1 of Article 9, or Paragraph 3 of the Graduate School Rules for Kanazawa University ("Graduate School Rules").

Those who can enroll as research students in the Doctoral Level Section of the Integrated Course are those who fall under any of the items in Article 11 of the Graduate School Rules.

Those who can enroll as research students in the Doctoral Program are those who fall under any of the items in Article 10, or Paragraph 2 of the Graduate School Rules.

4. Application method

5. Selection method

Selection and acceptance / rejection decisions will be made after a review of the documents. Successful applicants will be notified in writing.

6. Research period

As a general rule, the research period for research students is six months or one year. Please follow the instructions of the prospective faculty advisor.

7. Expenses required for research students

- (1) Examination fee: 9,800 yen
- (2) Enrollment fee: 84,600 yen (estimated)
- (3) Tuition fee: 29,700 yen (estimated) × (research period (number of months))
- *Tuition fees will be collected in two periods: first semester (April-September) and second semester (October-March).



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
